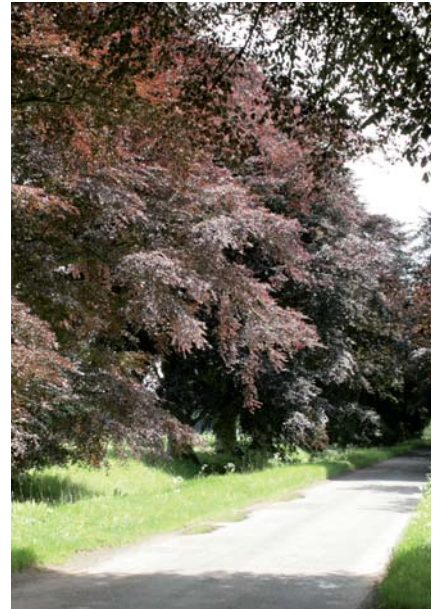

- Advice on new tree planting.



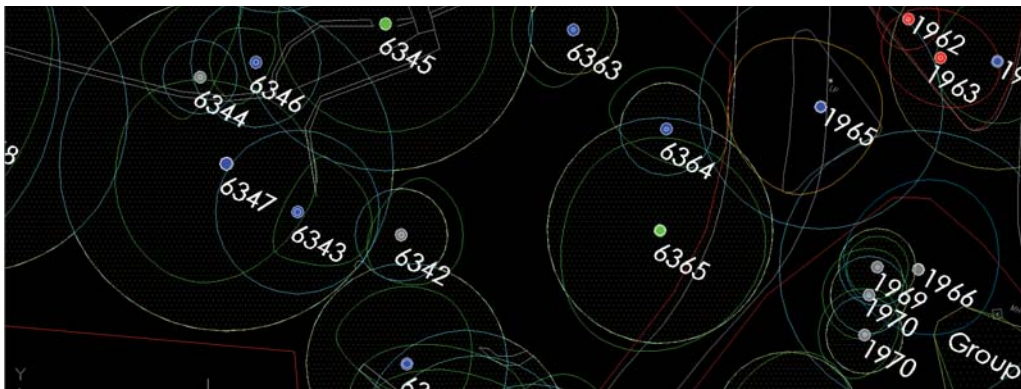
